As usual we will not be issuing paper tickets but will have a list of Season Ticket holders at the ticket desk. Remember tickets are transferable so you can give them to a friend if you can't come, they just need to tell us your name at the desk.

Finance

Donations are always welcome as ticket sales do not cover concert costs which include insurance, musicians' fees, overnight accommodation, travel, catering, piano tuning, adverts, hall rental and piano moving. When we apply for grants funders want/need to know we have local support; attendance figures and donations show this.

The Gift Aid Small Donations Scheme allows us to collect Gift Aid on amounts less than £20 without you having to fill in any forms.
