Our concerts are funded by ticket sales and we apply for an annual grant from Chamber Music Scotland – we are very pleased to have heard that this year's application was successful. Unfortunately, these two amounts do not cover costs which include musicians' fees, overnight accommodation, travel, catering and hall rental.
